A resident mentioned the changes needed for the Local Plan. The timetable for the plan is quite tight and expected to be ready for consultation by November 2025; the Parish Council will have an opportunity to respond within the consultation. By April 2026 the plan should be ready to be accepted by the government. The resident encouraged the PC to be proactive on this. The Neighbourhood Plan remains in force so continues to be valid and can be used to influence planning applications but will need to be changed to reflect the North Lincolnshire Plan.

2504/10 Community Matters and Open Space Management

- a) The Woodland Glade and Hollows – the Hollows now boasts a bench which looks impressive and has been used. The picnic table has been taken away and cleaned up and returned to a much more open space with the aim to improve the use of the area.

Fly tipping is a big issue within North Lincs; Dog Kennel Lane is in Elsham Parish and there are tyres tipped.
